

KWHALA Miss KY Celebration Points



- **5 Points can be earned each half of the show (examples below)**
 - Ribbon Presenter
 - Gate Money Collector
 - Show Ring Gate
 - Entry Booth
 - Class Runner
 - Flag Presentation
- **Points earned for 1 night show Vs multi night show**
 - 1 Night - 10 Points Total
 - 5 points for each half
 - Can leave to show horse and return(speak with center ring coordinator so they have coverage)
 - Multi Night Show(2 or 3 night) - 15 Points Total
 - 5 points for a half night
 - You can not earn more points if you work both halves all nights (not required to work the whole time)
 - Max points that can be earned are 15
 - Can leave to show horse and return(speak with center ring coordinator so they have coverage)
- **How points are counted at voting**
 - 100 General Membership Vote = 100 Votes
 - 1 point = 1 Vote

Example: 100 votes + 30 points = 130 Votes

KWHALA Miss KY Celebration Guidelines



1. Candidates must write a Bio about themselves and send it to the President of KWHALA with a short request/application to be a part of the program. With their contact info, the deadline is March 1st.
2. Paid Member of KWHA, that is attending school with a 3.0 GPA
3. She is to be between the ages of 15 to the age of 19 as of January 1st.
4. She is to be a member of the KWHA Juvenile Auxiliary or KWHA Ladies Auxiliary depending on age.
5. She is to work as a ribbon presenter at as many Horse shows as possible affiliated with KWHA.
6. She is required to be a ribbon presenter at 2 out of 3 major shows; they are as listed; Derby Classic, KWHA Juvenile, & KWHA Ladies Auxiliary Jubilee Show. The Kentucky Celebration will not count toward points due to the point deadline, but is mandatory.
7. The Candidate that is crowned Queen is to be an award presenter for the Trainers banquet and KWHA Banquet.
8. She is to present and represent herself in a professional manner.
9. No matter which lady is crowned Queen at the Kentucky Celebration your job of handing out ribbons still has to be completed the entire show unless showing your horse.
10. No gossiping, No rude behavior, nor making others feel less than, No sexual Harassment, will be tolerated within this program.
11. All Candidates are to be of a single status (not married) nor expecting a child while in the program. Candidates are to represent a princess, a future Queen.
12. Dressing modestly is a must, no short shorts or skirts, or tube tops. Absolutely no flip flops, sandals, or open toe shoes in the center ring around horses.
13. The Kentucky Celebration will be a formal event where you will need an escort.
14. If any Candidate is unable to perform their duties as requested when the voting ballots are mailed out to the KWHA members your name will be left off of the ballots.
15. As we all know things in life happen, the ladies are very understanding. If a problem arises and a duty can not be performed we are willing to help make other arrangements to help fulfill the duties of. We want you to have fun and make friends.
16. If you are crowned Queen you are not eligible to run again within the 15 to 19 age group.
